TOWN OF FRONT ROYAL SCHOLARSHIP

Two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each will be awarded to two graduating seniors who reside in the limits of the Town of Front Royal and who are pursuing continued undergraduate or trade education at an accredited university.

LEAF COLLECTION

Wednesdays Only October 21—January 13. Leaves may be placed in plastic lawn bags, biodegradable paper bags, 32 gallon garbage cans and reusable bins. Bags are not to be sealed or tied. There is no limit to the number of bags of leaves that can be placed at curbside during this period.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Wednesdays Only until January 13. All weeds, grass clippings, etc. may be placed in unsealed or untied plastic bags, biodegradable bags, or reusable containers. Do not mix trash, dirt, rocks with yard waste. Root balls, stumps, brush pulled by roots and firewood logs will not be accepted.

CHIPPER USE

Brush must be cut shorter than 5 feet in length and 10 inches in diameter and weigh less than 50 lbs and stacked. The chipper cannot take vines, weeping willow branches or bamboo. The Town does not collect contractor work. Contractors may purchase a dump ticket at the Administration Building, 102 E Main Street, to dispose of items at Manassas Avenue extended site.
